

Ordinance No. 30 2018

ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE PROJECT ID NO. 94224, THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SECTION AVE. BRIDGE OVER STATE ROUTE 562, AND AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE STATE OF OHIO NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has identified the need for the described project: Bridge maintenance to structure HAM-562-0179 to include replacing the curb, installing longitudinal joints, and patch street (PID 94224). The structure is the bridge which carries Section Ave. over SR 562 in Norwood, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Being in the public interest, the City of Norwood gives consent to the Director of Transportation for the State of Ohio to complete the above described project.

SECTION 2. The City of Norwood shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation for the State of Ohio in the above described project as follows: The Ohio Department of Transportation shall assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the costs of the State's highway improvement project. In the event that the City requests certain features or appurtenances be included within the State's highway improvement project, the City shall contribute one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of those items.

SECTION 3. The State of Ohio and City of Norwood agrees that all rights-of-ways required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The City of Norwood also understands that the right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs. The State of Ohio and City of Norwood agree that all utility accommodation, relocation, and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION 4. Upon completion of the described project and unless otherwise agreed, the City of Norwood shall provide adequate routine maintenance for the described project in accordance with all applicable State and Federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C. Section 116; provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the routine maintenance of the Project; maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public purpose.

SECTION 5. The Safety Service Director of said City of Norwood is hereby empowered to enter into contracts on behalf of the City of Norwood with the Director of Transportation for the State of Ohio necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the community and shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


