



Ordinance No. 25 2019

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH J.K. MEURER CORPORATION, THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE ALTERNATE BID FOR SECTION AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, (JMA #4061) (FROM ROSS AVENUE TO DALE ROAD) WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to improve the City of Norwood's half (eastern half) of Section Avenue, between Ross Avenue and Dale Road, including targeted full depth pavement repairs, curb ramp upgrades, milling the existing pavement 2.5" deep, overlaying 2.5" of new asphalt, and marking the pavement, (JMA #4061); and

WHEREAS, the Service-Safety Director has filed plans and specifications, has advertised for bids, has accepted sealed bids to complete the project pursuant to the plans and specifications, and has opened those, bids; and

WHEREAS, contractor J.K. Meurer Corporation's bid was the low bid of \$186,350.00 for the improvements, and the City has determined that J.K. Meurer Corporation is the lowest and best bidder for this alternate bid; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for Section Avenue Improvements (JMA#4061) for the alternate bid from Ross Avenue to Dale Road, pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director, and the alternate bid submitted by lowest and best bidder for the alternate bid, J.K. Meurer Corporation.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants totaling \$186,350.00 for the foregoing purpose out of **STREET FUND 02-0852-7600 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to complete a street improvement project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood.
