Ordinance No. 36 2019

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH J.K. MUERER FOR THE REPAVING AND RELINING OF THE COMMUNITY CENTER PARKING LOT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to help the City of Norwood benefit from outside funding to repave and reline the Community Center parking lot, including approximately \$53,305.00 from a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), for work which must be completed in 2019; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the repaving and relining of the Community Center parking lot with J.K. Muerer, the lowest and best bidder for \$53,305.00, pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to implement the repaving and relining project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood by enabling the City to benefit from approximately \$53,305.00 in grant money, which must be used in 2019.



This is to inform you that the bid price to resurface the Norwood Community Center lot with 2" asphalt has been opened. The total cost is \$57,305.00 from the bid. The total CDBG approved is \$55,000.00 to spend this year. In the bid estimate, there was a \$4,000 contingency which won't be needed. Therefore, if you take the \$4,000 from the bid, the cost will be \$53,305.00 which also includes relining the parking lot. I am requesting approval to enter into contract to get the lot completed this year.
