Ordinance No. 18 20 16

ORDINANCE REPEALING NORWOOD CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 761 REGULATING TATTOO ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, Chapter 761 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Norwood, which regulates tattoo establishments, was originally adopted in 1996, before the State of Ohio began to regulate such establishments, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3730 and Ohio Administrative Code section 3701-9, now authorize the Norwood Board of Health to license and inspect tattoo parlors to maintain health and safety standards, without the need for separate standards and regulations under the Norwood Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, professional staff in the Norwood Health Department has reported that the eight-page Chapter 761 of the Codified Ordinances is functionally obsolete and no longer helpful to the discharge of the Department's public health duties;

THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Norwood, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 761 is hereby repealed in its entirety, including, sections 761.01, 761.02, 761.03, 761.04; 761.05, 761.06, 761.07, 761.,08, 761.09, 761.10, and 761.99 which were ordained as Ordinance 33-1996 and Ordinance 9-1999.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency, and the emergency is the need to avoid inconsistent regulatory standards that might compromise the health and welfare of the community.
