

Ordinance No. 37 20 17

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE-SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT UNDER THE STATE BID PURCHASE PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FORD 2018 F-450 DUMP TRUCK, OUTFITTED WITH THE PROPER EQUIPMENT, FOR USE BY THE NORWOOD PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood Public Works Department requires an additional paramedic unit to better serve its citizens, and its employees in the performance of their duties; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Upon the City of Norwood Financial Planning and Supervision Commission's approval. of this purchase as part of the City of Norwood's Financial Plan, the Director of Public Service-Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract under the State Bid Purchase Program, in accordance with specifications filed in the office of the Director of Public Service-Safety and/or the Auditor's Office for the purchase of one (1) 2018 Ford F-450 dump truck outfitted with the proper equipment for use by the Norwood Public Works Department. The cost of the dump truck is as follows:

One 2018 Ford F-450 Dump Truck \$74,812.00

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay warrants in the amounts and according to the schedule, as outlined in the attached Exhibit A, for the purchase of the aforementioned vehicles, \$55,000.00 out of the GENERAL FUND 01, and \$19,812.00 out of PERMISSIVE TAX FUND 5, for the total of \$74,812.00.

SECTION 3. The Auditor is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, any and all financing agreements to obtain financing for the purchase of the aforementioned vehicle.


SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith prior to any increases in the price of the vehicle.


