**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND THANKING
THOSE WHO RESTORED THE M60A3 TANK, AND CLEANED UP
AND PLANTED FLOWERS AT VICTORY PARK,
IN OBSERVATION OF THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF
ARMISTICE DAY, ON NOVEMBER 11, 2018**

WHEREAS, a group of people have volunteered to restore the M60A3 Tank, and to clean up and plant flowers at Victory Park, on the northwest corner of Montgomery and Mills in the heart of the City of Norwood, to make Victory Park more attractive and enjoyable, and to enhance Victory Park's rededication on Sunday, November 11, 2018, in observation of the 100th anniversary of Armistice Day, the day of the cessation of hostilities on the Western Front of World War I between the Allies and Germany, a war in which 40 citizens of Norwood sacrificed their lives in military service to the United States of America; and


