RESOLUTION HONORING DEB ROBISON

WHEREAS, Deb Robison joined the Norwood City Schools twenty-two years ago, initially as part of the Family and Children First initiative; and

WHEREAS, Deb Robison, a social worker by profession, has spent those twenty-two years focused on serving students in Norwood, particularly in providing mental health support; and

WHEREAS, Deb Robison has touched the lives of hundreds of Norwood families by initiating, coordinating, or serving with such programs as:

- The After School Program providing student enrichment activities;
- “Norwood Ready Kids,” providing early childhood education opportunities;
- Preventing Injuries in Norwood (PIN) with Cincinnati Children’s Hospital to provide safety equipment in homes with children under age five;
- The Center for Better Health and Nutrition with Cincinnati Children’s Hospital to improve the health of Norwood’s high school students;
- Safe Routes to School, with Donna Laake, to obtain nearly \$800,000 worth of infrastructure improvements to increase student safety

WHEREAS, the efforts of Deb Robison and others led to Norwood being named among the “100 Best Communities for Children for Young People”; and

WHEREAS, to the dismay of Norwood City Council, but with their best wishes, Deb Robison has accepted a new position with Miami University; and
