Resolution No. 14 20 18

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE HAMILTON COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood, Ohio is vulnerable to an array of natural, technological, and human-caused hazards that have the potential to cause loss of life and damages to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Emergency Management & Homeland Security Agency and the Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee, comprised of representatives from the County, municipalities, and stakeholder organizations, have prepared a recommended Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan that reviews the options to protect people and property and reduce damage from these hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood has participated in the planning process for development of this Plan, providing information specific to local and county-wide hazard priorities, encouraging public participation, identifying desired hazard mitigation strategies, and reviewing the draft Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Emergency Management & Homeland Security Agency, with the Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee, has developed the HAMILTON COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (the "Plan") as an official document of the County pursuant to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (PL-106-390) and associated regulations (44 CFR 201.6); and

WHEREAS, the Plan has been widely circulated for review by the County's residents, municipal officials, and regional, state, and federal partner agencies and has been revised to reflect their concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency have reviewed the Plan for legislative compliance and approved the plan pending the completion of local adoption procedures.

WHEREAS, the FEMA regulation 201.6 requires:

"Documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan (e.g. City Council, County Commissioner, Tribal Council). For multiple-jurisdiction plans each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that it has been formally adopted"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1 Council hereby approves and adopts the "Hamilton County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan" for the City of Norwood.

SECTION 2 Council requests that the City of Norwood Safety Departments and Service-Safety Director be charged with supervising the implementation of the Plan's recommendations, as they pertain to The City of Norwood and within the funding limitations as provided by the Council of the City of Norwood or other sources.

SECTION 3 The Clerk of Council is authorized to certify copies of this Resolution to the Hamilton County Emergency Management Agency.
