**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND THANKING
MULTI-COLOR CORPORATION - GLOBAL LABEL SOLUTIONS**

WHEREAS, The Multi-Color Corporation - Global Label Solutions, a business located on Beech Street in the historic United States Printing building, part of a multi-national corporation, with 47 high-tech facilities on six continents, supplies premium heat transfer labels to a variety of market segments: Food & Beverage, Industrial, Security, and other specialty niches; and

WHEREAS, Multi-Color Corporation's Norwood facility also manufactures its own heat transfer parts & equipment, allowing the company to provide a full system solution to this special label niche; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, in celebration of its 100th year in business, Multi-Color Corporation, having expressed interest in getting involved in the Norwood community, chose Dorl Field, located directly across Beech Street from Multi-Color Corporation's Norwood facility, as a location at which the company could make an immediate positive impact; and


