## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE UPDATE OF THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 3734, Ohio Revised Code (the "Act"), the Hamilton County Solid Waste Management District Policy Committee (the "Policy Committee") has adopted an update of the solid waste management plan (the "Plan Update") for the Hamilton County Solid Waste Management District (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Board of County Commissioners in the District, and the legislative authority of each municipal corporation or township under the jurisdiction of the District, must approve or disapprove the Plan Update by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Norwood has reviewed the Plan Update and has determined that the Plan Update is in the best interests of the City of Norwood; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, Hamilton County, State of Ohio, that:

- **SECTION 1.** Approval of the Plan Update. This Council of the City of Norwood, Ohio hereby approves the Hamilton County Plan Update, a true and correct copy of which is on file in the Clerk of Council Office.
- **SECTION 2.** Compliance with Open Meetings Law. It is hereby certified that all formal actions of City Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of City Council and that all deliberations of City Council were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section §121.22, Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 3.** <u>Forwarding of Resolution</u>. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to promptly deliver, or cause to be delivered, a copy of this Resolution to the Hamilton County Solid Waste Management District.
- **SECTION 4.** Emergency This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare of the City of Norwood, the reason for the emergency being the need to comply with statutory provisions and to proceed with solid waste management policies without delay in order to properly serve the City of Norwood.
